STAFF PROFESSIONAL LEARNING DAY

Mon April 30th

Pupil Free (Students start Tues May 1st)

On this day, Monday, 30/4/18, staff will be working **offsite** on **Geometric Reasoning** with Ann Downton from Monash University. Apologies if your family is inconvenienced with child care arrangements on this day.

What is Geometric Reasoning?

Geometric Reasoning is the use of critical thinking and reasoning to solve problems and find new relationships while working with different 2D geometric shapes.

This will encourage your child to visualise, reason and develop a stronger understanding of space (shapes).

What is Geometric Reasoning?

There are 5 big ideas within Geometric Reasoning:

Students learn

- Congruence by exploring the properties of different shapes.
- Similarity by exploring proportion of shapes.
- Geometric Proof by communicating their thinking and reasoning.
- New skills and shape relationships by exploring the properties of circles.

I will explore each of these ideas over the coming newsletters.

Maths words of the week

Doubles: Is a strategy used in Addition and Subtraction. It is a number that is added to itself. For example double 2 is 4, double 10 is 20. Double 100 is 200.

Known Facts: Facts that students know and can quickly recall. For example I know that 6 and 4 is 10. I know that 13+ 20= 33.



Reading and Comprehension Clusters:

Part of our literacy data collection is plotting each student on the reading and comprehension clusters. Each child will bring home their reading and comprehension data sheets next week so parents know where their child is operating at in regards to their year grade.

If you have any questions about this please see your child's teacher. Remember the holidays are a perfect time for reading new books and visiting libraries!!


Our wonderful grandparents (and parents) are welcome to come along to celebrate a great term of learning. All are invited to visit any classroom and view students' work.

A LEARNING SLUMP?

With the school break rapidly approaching.....it is time to think about the HOLIDAY SLUMP!!

After all the learning successes the children have enjoyed this term, it would be a huge shame to go BACKWARDS.... and just like an athlete needs to continually train or lose performance, your child also needs to continue daily reading, writing, spelling, numbers and so on to maintain peak learning fitness or else decline quickly and significantly!



Medications Procedures

If your child has an EpiPen at school, it is stored in a red pouch in their classroom - with your child's photo. Full instructions on the use of an EpiPen is in your child's class near their EpiPen (picture below). Teachers have been instructed as to how to use an EpiPen.

Students with doctor diagnosed **Asthma/Anaphylaxis/Type 1 Diabetes** are given a rubber wristband (picture below) to wear at school. This assists teachers, especially on playground duty to quickly identify the child's needs should they become ill. The wristbands will be returned to the teacher at the end of the day. (If you child accidentally brings one home please return it to school the next day.)
