

Why is my Child's Teacher out of Class?

Like professionals in other fields, all teachers are required to keep up to date with current thinking on best practices for learning. Imagine doctors not keeping updated on new developments in their area of expertise...

Over the weeks ahead, teachers have been asked to assess every K-6 student with Maths while K-2 have end of year literacy assessments. Time is provided to allow this process to happen.

Also, from time to time teachers are required to attend professional development opportunities to learn about changes to curriculum or new methods of teaching & learning.

These sessions sometimes occur during the day, after school or during the school holidays.

Teachers also have entitlements such as long service leave, maternity leave, family leave, sick leave, bereavement leave, jury duty, etc. Consequently there will be times when your child's teacher is absent from the classroom.

On these days, the teacher's learning programs are followed. Teachers on a grade work closely together and this allows the grade partner to liaise with the relief teacher so that good teaching and learning continues and routines are kept.

Dear Parents


At the Parent Forum in Week 5, we announced the changes that were to take place as part of the Catholic Education Diocese of Parramatta (CEDP) rollover of the updated ICT Network.

As part of the rollover a number of devices will no longer work on the new network. A list of devices can be found at the end of this article. To ensure a smooth rollover, a letter will be going home to any of the students, who have their own device and are affected by this change.

I have included a list of devices that you might like to consider purchasing instead. There is NO expectation that you must replace the device. Students will still have access to school devices. The school is working diligently to minimise the effect on school resources.

CEDP has set up a portal in which you can buy a suitable device. I will give you details of this portal in future newsletters as it is not yet ready. If you have any issues you would like to discuss about the BYOLT program please contact the office and ask to speak to me.

St Aidan's will be completing 2018 Mathematical Assessment Interviews (MAIs) at the <u>end of 2017</u>.

These will be done during class time in Week 8 and 9 of Term 4 (27 of November- 6th December) and <u>NOT</u> at the start of the year as previously done.

Teachers will be released during this time to complete the interviews.

Being on Time

Attendance is not just about being at school but also about being on time. Being late 5 minutes a day equals 25 minutes over a week, 250 minutes a term or 4 hours per term, or the equivalent of 3-4 days per year and over the schooling years is equivalent to one whole term of missed learning time. When a student arrives late they have often missed the introduction to a lesson and they have missed time socialising with their peers.
