

Homework

St Aidan's homework policy has changed this year to make it more relevant to student needs. The changes are listed below. Homework will be given each night from Monday to Thursday and will consist of reading, writing and numeracy. There will be no homework contracts.

Parents are asked to view and sign homework each night.

The following timeframe is set for each grade:

Kindergarten and year one 20 minutes each night

Year two
 Years three and four
 Years five and six
 Years five and six

25 minutes each night
30-40 minutes each night
40-50 minutes each night

Kindergarten

• term 1 practise sight words 5 minutes. Reading 10 minutes. Practise numeracy goal.

• terms 2-4 writing (story writing) 10-15 minutes and continue with reading and numeracy as for term 1.

Years one to six

reading each night sight words for some students
 writing Mondays and Wednesdays
 numeracy Tuesdays and Thursdays

It is expected that writing and numeracy will be a continuation of the work being done in class.

Numeracy may also include practise of the students' goals and number facts for quick recall, as per teacher's instructions Please contact your child's teacher if you have any questions or need clarification about homework.

Supervision

- Gates are opened and teacher supervision begins at 8:15am
- Parents may escort their children onto the playground and due to child protection are required to wait in the parent waiting area (silver seats) near the year four classroom.
- The bell rings at 8:40am—students walk quietly to lines
- After assembly parents are asked to move out of the playground through the gate between year two and Kindergarten.
- Gates are locked promptly once parents leave
- In the afternoon the dismissal bell rings at 2:55pm. Parents may wait in the shade area near the church garden or park in the surrounding streets. Children are walked by a teacher to the upper crossing in Adelaide Street and to the Kimberley Street crossing to meet parents.
- Supervision of students finishes at 3:25pm.
